Herbert Schreiber (Ulm, Germany)



Herbert Schreiber is Professor of Neurology and Extraordinary Professor at the Medical Faculty of Ulm University, Ulm, Germany, where he also served as Vice and Interim Chairman of the Department of Neurology from 1993–2001. Since then, he has been a partner in a private association of seven neurologists and is involved in student training and dissertations at Ulm University.

Alongside his medical and neurological residency training, he holds a specialist degree in neuromuscular disorders from the Sorbonne University in Paris, France, and further specialist degrees in pain medicine and neurorehabilitation.

He is a co-founder of the German Practice Study Group on MS within the national NeuroTransData network of neurologists, which is currently conducting several nationwide multicentre trials to investigate the influence of MS and its therapeutic interventions on imaging and clinical parameters, cognition and fatigue.

His areas of research interest include neuropsychology and the brain-imaging aspects of cognition in neurodegenerative and inflammatory brain diseases.
