Giancarlo Comi (Milan, Italy)



Giancarlo Comi is Honorary Professor of Neurology at the Università Vita-Salute San Raffaele, Milan, Italy and Founder and Director of the Institute of Experimental Neurology at the Scientific Institute San Raffaele. He is President of the European Charcot Foundation and is Vice-Chair of the Progressive MS Alliance and Co-Chair of the Industry Forum of the Alliance since 2013. He has been President of the European Neurology Society, of the Italian Society of Neurology and of the Italian Society of Clinical Neurophysiology, and is a fellow of the European Academy of Neurology.

Dr Comi has received several awards, including The Multiple Sclerosis (MS) International Federation Charcot Award for MS Research, the Gold Medal of 'Benemerenza Civica' from the City of Milan and the Official Honour of Merit from the President of the Republic of Italy.

His research interests include clinical MS treatment, biomarkers and mechanistic studies, neurophysiology, and clinical neurology. He has been a Principal Investigator for many Phase II and III MS clinical trials.

He has authored/co-authored >1000 articles in peer-reviewed journals, with an H index of 115; he is Co-Editor for Neurological Sciences and sits on the editorial boards of many international journals.
