Carlo Pozzilli (Rome, Italy)



Carlo Pozzilli has been Professor of Clinical Neurology at the Department of Neurology, University of Rome "La Sapienza", Rome, Italy, since 2006. He has also been Chief of the MS centre of Ospedale S. Andrea at the University since 2002. He obtained his PhD in Clinical Neurosciences at the University in 1987. In 1986, he received a research grant in neuroimaging at Tohoku University, Sendai, Japan, and in 1983, he became a Board Certified Neurologist at the University of Rome. In 1980, after studying at the University of Rome, he conducted research at Hammersmith Hospital, London, UK.

Dr Pozzilli's fields of interest include the clinical aspects and treatment of MS, on which he has published more than 350 papers and reviews. He has participated as a First Investigator in at least 250 multicentre clinical trials in patients with MS and was a member of the Steering Committee and Advisory Board for several multicentre trials. He is also a member of several national and international societies.
