Mathias Mäurer, MD, MHBA, is Professor of Neurology at the Julius Maximilians University of Würzburg in Würzburg, Germany. He also serves as the Director of the Department of Neurology, Klinikum Würzburg Mitte, Würzburg.

Dr Mäurer received his Doctor of Medicine and completed his post-doctorate fellowship at the University of Würzburg. He served as the research group leader for the Multiple Sclerosis and Neuroimmunology Clinical Research Unit at the University of Würzburg. He received a Master of Health Business Administration from the University of Erlangen-Nuremberg.

In 2001, Dr Mäurer was awarded the Young Scientist Prize of the Roman, Marga and Mareille Sobek Foundation for his scientific achievements. Since 2011, he has been a member of the Medical Advisory Board of Aktion Multiple Sklerose Erkrankter, Landesverband (AMSEL) and the German MS Society (DMSG).
