Since 2013, Paloma Montero-Escribano has worked for the Neurology Service at the University Hospital Clínico San Carlos, Madrid, Spain, where she is responsible for the Spasticity Unit. She is also a member of the Demyelinating Diseases Unit at the hospital.

She graduated from the University Autónoma, Madrid, Spain, and completed her residency in the Department of Neurology at the University Hospital of Getafe, Madrid, Spain. Following this, she earned a master's degree in medical investigation from Rey Juan Carlos University, Madrid, Spain, and a master's degree in musculoskeletal ultrasound and guided intervention from San Pablo CEU University, Seville, Spain.

Her main research interest is in patients with MS, focussing on their treatment and the management of their symptoms. She is particularly interested in the pharmacological treatment of spasticity, the ultrasound-guided administration of botulinum toxin and the programming and monitoring of intrathecal baclofen pumps.
