Jens Kuhle (Basel, Switzerland)



Jens Kuhle was appointed as Head of the newly founded Multiple Sclerosis Centre at the University Hospital Basel, Basel, Switzerland, in 2018. He is also Principal Investigator for the Swiss MS Cohort Study, a national academic network dedicated to biomarker and outcome research in MS.

He obtained his MD from the Eberhard Karls University of Tübingen, Germany, and specialised in Neurology and Neuroimmunology at the University Hospital Basel.

He acts as a Reviewer for the Swiss, UK and American Multiple Sclerosis Societies and for multiple MS-related journals. His research interests focus on biofluid markers related to the course and outcome of neurological diseases in general and, specifically, on establishing neurofilament light chains as the first blood-based biomarker in MS. Based on this research, he received his PhD in Neuroimmunology at Queen Mary University, London, UK, in 2014.
