Giacomo Lus (Naples, Italy)



Since 2007, Giacomo Lus has been responsible for the MS Centre in the Department of Neurosciences, University of Campania, Naples, Italy, and since 2001 he has been an Assistant Professor in Neurology at the II Neurological Clinic there. Before this, from 1988, Giacomo Lus was Assistant Neurologist in the Second Neurological Clinic, First Faculty of Medicine, University of Naples – Federico II, Naples, Italy.

He has participated in several clinical trials and has coordinated both national and international research projects in MS, focussing on neuropsychology, clinical epidemiology, prognosis and therapy. He is an author of more than 80 publications in peer-reviewed journals.

He is a member of the Campania Regional Board: Project Line 2.6 – Health Economics and Management Tools, which supports the implementation of the Diagnostic Therapeutic Care Pathway and the network between centres for the diagnosis and treatment of MS. He is a member of the American Academy of Neurology, the Italian Society of Neurology and the Italian Study Group for MS.
