Melinda Magyari is the Director of the Danish Multiple Sclerosis Registry, a Consultant Neurologist at the Danish Multiple Sclerosis Center, University Hospital Copenhagen, Rigshospitalet, Copenhagen, Denmark, and an Associate Professor at the University of Copenhagen, Copenhagen, Denmark.

Her major research interest is in MS and other inflammatory disorders of the central nervous system, with a special interest in changing epidemiology, gender differences and real-world evidence.

In the past, Melinda Magyari has been involved in epidemiological studies, addressing questions regarding comorbidities, reproductive issues and risk factors in MS. Her current research focuses on observational studies investigating the effectiveness, safety and socioeconomic consequences of disease-modifying therapies in MS. She is strongly involved in international collaborations with other MS registries and is a Member of the Big MS Data Network Steering Committee.

She is a member of several national and international scientific committees, including the Scientific Panel of the European Academy of Neurology.
