Christoph Kleinschnitz, MD, Consultant of Neurology and Neurological Intensive Care and an MHBA, is Professor and Head of the Department of Neurology at the University Hospital of Essen, Essen, Germany. Before his current position, he was Head of the Stroke Unit and Deputy of the Clinical Research Group for Multiple Sclerosis and Neuroimmunology at the University of Würzburg, Würzburg, Germany.

His research interests include the disease mechanisms in MS, ischaemic stroke and cardiovascular diseases, with a strong focus on translational and clinical studies. He is on the Editorial Board of *Stroke and the Journal of Cerebral Blood Flow and Metabolism*, is a Scientific Advisor for multiple scientific foundations and is a Member of the Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft (DFG) Scientific Program Review Board for Neuroscience. His scientific excellence has led to more than 300 publications (Hirsch-index of 47) and, since 2019, he is the Speaker of the DFG Research Unit FOR 2879: ImmunoStroke: From immune cells to stroke recovery.
